Update: Plane Crash at Albert Whitted Airport

At approximately 4:20 p.m. today, a civilian-owned T-34 military plane was attempting a landing at Albert Whitted Airport, 101 8th Avenue Southeast. The pilot came in too low and clipped the seawall, resulting in minor damage to the aircraft. There were no injuries to the pilot or his passenger.

The crash is being investigated by Albert Whitted Airport and aviation authorities.
