Shooting Update:

Spelling correction on the middle name: Timothy Karl Davis, Jr

The victim of the shooting is identified as Timothy Carl Davis, Jr. DOB 9-16-82.

Additional information:

Officers arrived on the scene approximately 90 seconds after police received the call of a shooting. The officers administered CPR until Fire Rescue Units arrived and took over. Despite those efforts, he died.

We received information that Davis had been involved in a dispute with another person in the last few days. We would like to speak to anyone who knows about this to determine whether it was related to the shooting.

There were several people in the area and we spoke to many potential witnesses. Investigators urge anyone with information to please contact police.

-----previously released----- Investigators do not believe this was a random shooting and are presently interviewing witnesses. We have no suspect information to release at this time.

St. Petersburg detectives are on the scene of a shooting that left a man dead. It occurred just after 6:30 p.m. near the intersection of 11th Ave S and 23rd St. South.

When police arrived, the victim, a 34 year old man, was found in the street.

It is early in the investigation and no other information will be released at this time.
