DUI Wolf Pack Results

On Friday, November 3rd, 2017 between the hours of 6pm-4am, the St Petersburg Police Department alongside the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, Florida Highway Patrol and the Gulfport, Largo, Clearwater and Pinellas Park Police Departments hosted a DUI Wolf Pack in the city. These agencies worked together under the Pinellas County Combined Mutual Aid Agreement.

There were 12 DUI arrests, 9 driving while license suspended arrests, 2 misdemeanor drug arrests, 1 felony arrest and 3 misdemeanor arrests.

Additionally, 62 speeding violations and 199 citations were issued.

The purpose of the DUI Wolf Pack is to protect our community from the perils of drunk driving. With so many options available (like taxi cabs, Uber, Lyft etc.) there is no need to risk anyone's safety.

DUI Wolf Packs are held periodically to discourage drunk driving and minimize safety risks.
