Update: Officer Involved Shooting

The officers involved in this morning's shooting are 10-year veteran Matthew Laliberte and 3-year veteran Andre Sousa.

Both officers fired their weapons after 33-year-old Timothy Earl Jackson began shooting at them.

Officers Laliberte and Sousa are on administrative duty while our detectives and the Office of Professional Standards, as well as the State Attorneys'

Office investigate.

Update on Officer Involved Shooting:

At 8:45 p.m., Monday, a victim called to report a carjacking. He says two men blocked his pick-up truck as he was driving in the 4800 block of 20th Avenue South. One pointed a black semi-automatic gun at him and stole his white Toyota pick-up truck. #2017-048987

At 12:50 a.m. Wednesday, an officer spotted the stolen pick-up truck at the Choice Food Store @ 5th Ave S. and 34th Street.

The officer kept the truck under surveillance. The truck appeared to have a flat front tire and was driving very slowly, eventually turning east into the alley behind 2940 Freemont Terrace South.

Two patrol cruisers turned in behind him. The suspect bailed out of the truck and fired at the patrol cruiser. Two officers fired back.

The suspect died of his wounds at the hospital.

Suspect: Timothy Earl Jackson, 33 years old (DOB 7-12-84)

He served 8 years, 9 months in prison for robbery and was just released in August, this year.

Officers involved in the shooting have been placed on administrative duty pending the outcome of the investigation.

Update on Officer Involved Shooting:

Suspect died at the hospital. He was 33 years old.

-----previously released----- Shortly before 1 a.m., a patrol officer spotted a white pick up truck that had been involved stolen in an armed carjacking Monday evening. When the officer try to make a traffic stop, the pick up truck turned into an alleyway near 30th St. and 6th Ave., South. Two patrol cruisers turned in behind him.

There was an exchange of gunfire and the suspect was critically injured and transported to the hospital.

Photos are attached of the pick up truck and the Patrol cars in the alley. More details will be released at a press conference at 6:30 a.m. at Police Headquarters basement meeting room.
