Curfew

The City of St. Petersburg is enacting an emergency curfew at 5 p.m. due to severe weather conditions until further notice. It will remain in effect throughout the duration of the storm.

All residents need to be off the roads and taking shelter. Once winds reach 40+mph, police and fire will no longer be able to respond to citizen calls. They will resume responding once conditions are safe.
