Incident: Serious Bodily Injury Bicycle Crash

Location: 1600 block of 62nd Avenue North

Date / Time of Incident: 09/18/2017 2121 hours

Synopsis: A 2004 Cadillac four door, FL tag N902XB, being driven by Stephanie Nichole Brown (W/F, 04/05/1991, 7380 Organdy Dr N, St Pete), was westbound on 62nd Avenue North in the median lane. There was light to moderate traffic on the roadway. Eastbound/westbound traffic had a solid green light. For an unknown reason, a W/M bicyclist began crossing 62nd Avenue North from the north to the south, in the west crosswalk at the intersection of 16th Street North. The bicyclist had a solid green light. The bicyclist rode into the path of the oncoming Cadillac and was struck. The right front corner of the Cadillac struck the left side of the bicycle. This sent the bicyclist into the windshield and over the roof of the vehicle. The Cadillac came to rest shortly after the intersection. The W/M bicyclist, who had not been wearing a helmet, landed on the pavement and tumbled to final rest. He was transported to Bayfront Health St Petersburg in critical condition. Brown was unhurt.

Alcohol did not play a factor in this crash.
