Arrests Made in Tampa for St. Pete Robbery

At 2:56am on Thursday August 2, 2018 St. Petersburg Police became aware of a robbery that occurred at the Tamarind Bay Apartments (located at 11400 4th St. North).

Officers followed the suspects across the Howard Frankland Bridge to the area near Westshore and Kennedy Boulevards in Tampa, where the suspects crashed their car and ran. With the assistance of Tampa Police Department, three suspects were taken into custody.

Javon Scott (B/M DOB 05/06/1993), John A. Ellis (B/M DOB 11/6/1990) and Jienna Williams (B/F DOB 08/15/1989) are facing Armed Robbery charges from St. Petersburg Police.

Scott is facing a Carrying a Concealed Weapon charge, Ellis is facing a Felon in Possession of a Firearm charge, as well as a Violation of Probation - Fleeing and Eluding charge and Williams is facing an Aggravated Battery - Motor Vehicle charge from Tampa Police.

The investigation into these events continues.
