Update 2: Vehicle vs. Motor Scooter

The driver of the motor scooter, Michael Cardinal (10/28/1966), died from his injuries this morning at 12:44am.

The investigation into the crash continues.

Update: Vehicle vs Motor Scooter

Shortly after 5 p.m., a black 2016 Hyundai Elantra, driven by Terry Joiner (Male DOB 12/31/56), was traveling northbound on 16th Street North. A black 2017 Zhongneng Motor Scooter, operated by Michael Cardinal (DOB 10/28/1966), was westbound on 36th Avenue North, stopped at a stop sign then moved forward and failed to yield to the northbound vehicle.

Cardinal was not wearing a helmet and suffered life threatening injuries. He was transported to Bayfront Health St. Petersburg, where he remains in critical condition. The investigation is still on-going.

St. Petersburg Police is investigating a collision between a car and a motor scooter. It occurred shortly after 5pm at 36th Ave N and 16th St.

The scooter driver (an adult man) was critically injured. The driver of the car remained on scene and is cooperating with the investigation.

The area will remain closed to traffic during the investigation.
